### 2. Wheeling Charges:

The actual wheeling charges payable (after rounding off) will depend upon the point of injection & point of drawal as under:

The wheeling charges as determined above or applicable to all the Open access or wheeling transactions for using the CESC's network, except for energy transmitted or wheeled from renewable sources to the consumers within the state.

### 3. Tariff for Green Power;

In order to encourage generation and use of green power in the State, the Commission decides to continue the existing Green Tariff of 50 paise per unit as the additional tariff over and above the normal tariff to be paid by HT-consumers, who opt for supply of green power from out of the renewable energy procured by distribution utilities over and above their Renewable Purchase Obligation (RPO).

### ELECTRICITY TAX

As per Notification No. : DPAL 17 Shasana dated 19.07.2018 of the Government of Karnataka and Circular No.: CESC/CFO/GM(A&R)/DGM(A&R)/AGM(A&R)/M\*/CYS-696 dated:09.08.2018 of CESC, the Electricity Tax shall be levied on ad valorem basis @ 9% only on the Electricity consumption charges (exclusive of arrears, fixed charges / contract demand, D&R fee, etc.) payable by all consumers except

- (i) The consumers under agricultural (irrigation pump sets upto and inclusive of 10 HP.
- (ii) Bhagya Jyothi and Kuteera Jyothi categories up to the extent of free consumption allowed by the State Government from time to time.

This is effective from 1st meter reading date on or after 19th July 2018.
